



 Send your child to school in the manner they will typically arrive.




Kindergarteners will receive badges

What is PBIS?




- Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS) is a national initiative that supports a positive school climate while addressing behavioral needs and challenges
- The PBIS team meets regularly to:
 - Review school data
 - Plan incentives for positive behaviors
 - Support those students who are struggling with their behavior.

Instructional Grouping

• Students in grades K-5 are assigned to homerooms based upon reading levels.



- Groupings are based primarily on the student's current instructional level.
 - We will use data from your previous school as well as beginning of year assessments.
- Grouping remains flexible in response to strong academic growth or the need for greater academic support.

Student Wellness

- Review COVID guidelines on when to keep students home and protocols with identifying students with COVID symptoms in school.
- Masks are required to be worn at all times inside school, except for lunch.
- Hand sanitizers are available for use before lunch and after recess.
 - Individual hand sanitizers are allowed and encouraged; alcohol based hand sanitizers are the most effective.



Student Meals

- Breakfast and lunch are free, no prepaid or onsite payments required
- Breakfast will be eaten in the cafeteria
- Menus are available online at hcpss.nutrislice.com or through the HCPSS app



Indoor Lunch

- Students will eat at assigned seats in the cafeteria
 - 6-8 students per table
 - Plexiglass dividers will be used
- Students will remain masked when not actively eating
- Designated nut-free table available indoors



Outdoor Lunch

- When possible, to reduce the number of students in the cafeteria, every student will have an opportunity to eat outside on a rotating basis by class
- Nut free table will be available outdoors



Recess

- Daily
- 30 minutes of adult supervised free-play
- Masks are not required
- <u>Students should dress appropriately for the weather</u>.
 - Generally, students will be outside for recess when the temperature combined with the wind chill is not less than 20 degrees Fahrenheit and there is no falling precipitation.
