#### Health Room Update

A few weeks ago, we received notification of one confirmed case of chickenpox. We typically do not release specific information regarding the child in order to protect the privacy of the student. However, with the permission of this child's parent and at the parent's request, we are sharing the following - This student had been properly vaccinated against chickenpox (Varicella).

#### Per the CDC's website, http://www.cdc.gov/chickenpox/vaccination.html -

"The chickenpox vaccine is very effective. Two doses of the vaccine are about 98% effective at preventing chickenpox. Some people who are vaccinated against chickenpox may still get the disease. However, it is usually milder with fewer skin blisters and little or no fever." - <u>http://www.vaccines.gov/diseases/chickenpox/</u> Two percent of children who have been vaccinated will still get chickenpox.

"My child is shy and often knows the answer, but is afraid to raise his/her hand and would work best with a teacher who gently encourages participation."

There are certain concerns that we cannot consider as part of this Consideration form: therefore, we ask that you NOT use the form to propose the following:

- Specific teacher requests
- Grouping based on siblings' experiences
- Grouping with friends
- Grouping based on hearsay

- Grouping based on hearsay


